OVERALL RESPONSIBILITIES

The safety manager is responsible for providing guidance and direction for the planning, implementation and operation of the organization's aviation safety management system (SMS). Identifies potential safety risks through analysis of safety data. Monitors safety issues, provides safety education, investigates incidents and accidents, acts as a resident expert on safety matters, develops safety risk assessments, and makes recommendations to improve safety in the workplace. Brings value to WGA by mitigating potential costs from accidents or incidents. Complies with SMS requirements by documenting and facilitating safety programs. Empowers WGA employees as safety professionals by developing a positive safety culture.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES/KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Participate in the daily review of safety reports for the purpose of determining the scope of investigation, occurrence owner, event classification, and tracking within the safety database;
- Conduct safety investigations, analysis, and identification of the cause or probable cause of all hazards, incidents, and accidents identified under the safety management system;
- Conduct hazards analysis and risk assessments, as well as trend analysis on safety data;
- Evaluate effectiveness of corrective actions with respect to hazards, incidents, and accidents;
- Facilitate the Flight Data Monitoring Program (FDMP) to include managing, tracking and trending flight data to identify safety issues;
- Prepare and distribute reports on SMS performance to include the monitoring and analysis of trends from all data sources;
- Ensuring that safety-related documentation and records are current and accessible;
- Promote safety awareness on regular basis (e.g. station visits and newsletter articles);
- Deliver SMS specific training (e.g. investigation, root causes analysis);
- Manage safety meetings and attend symposiums (e.g. safety committee);
- Additional tasks as assigned by the Director of Safety & Security.

The above responsibilities, duties, and skills are intended to describe the general requirements of the position. They are not intended to be an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties and skills required.

- Post-secondary education in a related field, or an equivalent level of education and experience;
- Minimum three (3) years of experience in the aviation industry, preferably in one of the following functional areas: Flight Ops, Maintenance & Engineering, Ground Handling;
- Knowledge of Federal Aviation Regulations, and Safety Management System principles and practices;
- Proficient verbal, written and presentation communication skills;
- Proficient in the use of computer applications, such as MS Word, Excel and Power point;
- Demonstrated organizational, planning and administrative skills;
- Demonstrated problem solving and analytical skills;
- Ability to work unsupervised and remain calm under stressful conditions;
- Short-notice travel availability; holds current passport.
